\*Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is a way for the public to buy locally grown food, create a relationship with a farm, and help to keep small farms in their community. Members make a financial commitment to the farm by buying shares, which provide the farm with the funds needed to grow and harvest the crops. The shareholders share the bounty with the farmer-when the harvest is plentiful the shares are large. However, just as when you buy stock in any company, CSA shareholders also take risks. If a natural disaster (such as hurricane or other weather-related condition or a major pest problem) destroys a crop, the shareholders bear the burden along with the farmer.

Donations – many of you have asked about making a donation to the farm. Gateway Organic Farm is a for-profit company. Donations are not tax deductible. Any donation, be it monetary, materials, or time will be greatly appreciated and utilized to the fullest.
